TRADE CONTROL SANCTIONS COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

Comprehensive sanctions programmes have been in force against Iran, with enhanced measures over the recent years, to persuade Iran from developing its disputed nuclear program. Many of these sanctions are targeted at the nuclear, petroleum, banking and insurance industries, also against individuals, organizations and companies that have been identified by the United Nations, European Union and UAE.

Alternatively, exports of licensable items must be appropriately identified by customers, who must provide us with information and all necessary documentation, including valid licenses, to comply with applicable regulations.

Additionally, please be aware that Ibrakom does not accept items of U.S. origin for carriage to Iran from any origin in the world.

- The International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) administered by the United States Department of State.
- US Sanctions administered by the United States Department of the Treasury.
- United Nations Sanctions
- All applicable UAE laws, including Federal Law Number 13 of 2007, addressing commodities subject to import and export control procedure

In no event shall we use, transfer, release, export or re-export any such hardware, software or technology in violation of such applicable laws, regulations, orders or requirements or the requirements of any licences, authorisations or licence exceptions relating thereto.
